

Agreement on Use of the KIT Business Club

between

Karlsruhe Institute of Technology

- hereinafter referred to as “KIT” -

and

[Name of Company]

- hereinafter referred to as “PARTNER” -

Article 1 - Accession

The PARTNER accedes to the KIT Business Club on [Date]. The KIT Business Club is a communication and service offer and a network for cooperation partners of KIT.

Article 2 – Rights and Obligations

The PARTNER shall be obliged to pay an annual fee. Payment conditions and the amount of the fee are outlined in the Statutes of the KIT Business Club and their annexes as amended.

KIT shall be obliged to render the services outlined in the Statutes of the KIT Business Club and their annexes as amended.

As for the rest, the rights and obligations of the parties shall result from the Statutes of the KIT Business Club and their annexes as amended.

Article 3 – Liability

KIT shall execute properly and to the best of its knowledge the services to be rendered within the framework of the Statutes of the KIT Business Club taking into account the state of the art.

KIT's liability to the PARTNER for any damage not caused by an injury to life, body or health shall be excluded. This shall not apply to damage resulting from a grossly negligent or intentional violation of an obligation by a legal representative or subcontractor of KIT.

Article 4 – Other Provisions

The Statutes of the KIT Business Club with Annexes A and B shall be integral constituents of this Agreement. The PARTNER shall confirm receipt.

Article 5 – Data Transmission

For the administration of its partners, for rendering its services as outlined in the Statutes, and for statistical evaluations, the KIT Business Club collects, processes, and uses the following personal data of employees of its partners:

- Personal data, in particular name, contact data, positions or titles,
- main activities and interests relating to the research areas of KIT, and
- comparable personal data.

For this purpose, the KIT Business Club is authorized to transmit personal data of employees of the partners to employees of KIT and subcontractors. The KIT Business Club shall observe the provisions of data protection legislation, in particular data secrecy (Art. 3, par. 2, LDSG) and security of processing (Art. 32, GDPR), oblige its employees and subcontractors accordingly, and make them familiar with the data protection regulations.
